

Ordinance No. 110

An Ordinance to prohibit the wearing or putting a bell upon any animal owned and kept within the limits of the City of Albany.

Be it Ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany

Section 1 That the wearing by or putting a bell upon any animal owned and kept by any resident of said City to be worn by such animal within the City limits, is hereby declared a nuisance and the Marshal is hereby authorized and empowered to remove the same.

Section 2 Any resident of said City violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance by allowing his or her animal to wear a bell within the City limits or by putting a bell upon his or her animal kept within the City limits and to be worn therein shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction before the City Recorder shall be fined Five Dollars for each offence.

Section 3 This Ordinance shall be in force from and after five days after its publication.
