

Ordinance No. 127.

An Ordinance to amend Section 3. of Ordinance 4.

Be ordained by the Common Council of the City of Albany,

Sec I No person, or persons shall fire any pistol, gun or rifle, or any description of fire arms, or discharge any air gun, bow, or instrument whatever, unless by permission of the Marshal, within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, under penalty of not less than ten nor more than fifty dollar fine, or imprisonment not exceeding (20) days, twenty days or confinement thereof before the Recorder.

Sec II The Marshal may permit such displays on national holidays, and other set days; but he shall use all diligence, and care to prevent any evil arising therefrom, and should he fear or anticipate any danger, it shall be his duty at once to prohibit it, and he shall then strictly, and rigidly enforce this section.

Sec III This Ordinance to be in force from, and after five days after its publication.
