An Ordinance to amend Section 3 of Ordinance No 165, entitled "An Ordinance relating to the material to be used and the manner of building sidewalk and crosswalks".

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. All sidewalks on First Street in the City of Albany, except the sidewalks between Washington and Ellsworth Streets on said First Street, shall be ten feet wide, and shall be constructed as follows, to wit: Bearings four inches thick by four inches wide shall be laid on the ground, or when necessary on stone or brick fillow; there shall be at least five bearing under each section of walk of eighteen feet length and they shall be placed at equal distances apart; there shall be laid on said bearings four tiers of stringers to be three inches thick by four inches wide, to be laid down at equal distances apart and securely nailed to the bearings with thirty penny nails; the decking shall be one and one half inches thick, of red or yellow fir, square-edged, evenly fitted and nailed to the stringers with twelve penny nails, to be not more than eight inches wide nor less than four inches wide, and all to be constructed in a good and workmanlike manner; Provided, however, that that said walks may be constructed and laid down in the same manner and

of like material as the sidewalks
 (~~on the~~) now in use on the north side
 of First Street in front of the Linn
 County Bank and the Foster Block.
 All sidewalk hereafter to be constructed
 on First Street in said city; between
 Washington and Ellsworth Streets, shall
 be twelve feet wide and shall be con-
 -structed in the manner herein before for
 a ten foot walk so far as the same is
 applicable.

Section 2 That all ordinances or parts of ordinances
 in conflict with this ordinance, are hereby
 repealed.

Section 3 This ordinance shall take effect and
 be in full force from and after its
 approval by the mayor.
