

Ordinance No: 207.

An Ordinance to amend Sections one (1) and (3) three of Ordinance Number 201, passed by the Council July 24th 1890, and approved by the Mayor August 1st 1890, entitled, "An Ordinance to amend Sections one and three of Ordinance No. 180, passed by the Council June 26th 1888, entitled an Ordinance to amend Sections one and three of an Ordinance, entitled, an Ordinance relating to the establishing of grade of streets in the City of Albany, passed by the ^{Commons,} Council December 14th 1876."

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That Sections one (1) and three (3) of Ordinance Number 201, passed by the Council July 24th 1890, and approved by the Mayor August 1st 1890, entitled "An Ordinance to amend Sections one and three of Ordinance No. 180," entitled "An Ordinance to amend Section one and three of an Ordinance entitled, "Ordinance relating to the establishing of grade of streets in the City of Albany, passed by the Commons Council December 14th 1876," be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 1: The established grade of the streets of the City of ^{Albany} in ^{Union} County Oregon, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by Surveyor Warner in the year 1876, and now on file in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany, except that the established

grade of Baker street, and Montgomery street, between Fourth street, and Seventh street, and the established grade of Fifth street, Sixth street, and Seventh street, between Fourth street and Railroad street shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor W. B. Barr, in the year 1888, and adopted by the Common Council June 12th 1888, and now on file in the office of the City Recorder, and except that the established grade of Second street, Third street, and Fourth street, from the east line of Vine street, to the west line of Washington street, and of Calaveras street from the north line of ^{Receipt} ~~Fourth~~ ^{to the north line of Fourth street} street, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by J. A. Mames in the year 1890, and adopted by the Common Council July 8th 1890, and now on file in the office of the City Recorder, and except that the established grade of Fourth street between Baker street and Railroad street, be in conformity to the survey and plat made by J. A. Mames in the year 1890, and adopted by the Common Council October 14th 1890 and now on file in the office of the City Recorder.

Section 3: The center of the finished street shall conform to the established grade, the gutters to be eight-tenths (8/10) of a foot lower than the center of street, and there shall be not less than (6) six inches of gravel in the center of the street, and not less than (3) three inches of gravel at the edge of gutter.

Section 4: All Ordinances, or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force and after its approval by the Mayor.
