

Ordinance No. 205.

An Ordinance to declare any person guilty of a misdemeanor who shall suffer any poultry to run at large within the limits of the City of Albany, and to provide a punishment for such offence, and to define what shall be deemed a running at large of poultry.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: Hereafter in any person who is the owner, or who has the control or possession of any poultry, shall suffer such poultry to run at large within the limits of the City of Albany such person shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be fined in a sum not less than \$50 nor more than \$200, or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than 2-days nor more than 10-days.

Section 2: Any poultry, at any time hereafter found running on any premises in the City of Albany, to which premises the owner or person in possession or control at the time of such poultry, has no right of possession, or permission or authority from the owner or person in possession or control of such premises, allowing such poultry to run thereon shall for the purposes of this Ordinance be deemed running at large in the City of Albany.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after five days from its approval by the Mayor.

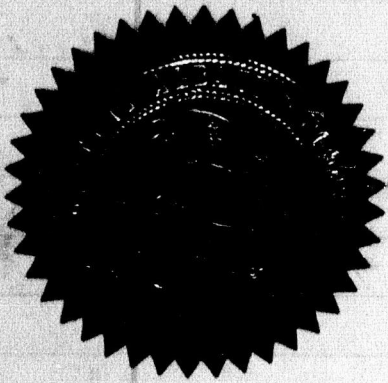
