

Ordinance No 207

An ordinance declaring it to be a misdemeanor for any person or persons to keep any hog or hogs within the limits of the City of Albany, and to provide a punishment for such offense.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Hereafter any person or persons who shall keep, within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, any hog or hogs, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, before the Recorder Court, shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$20.00, or be imprisoned in the City Jail, not less than 2 days nor more than 10 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force after its approval by the Mayor
