

Ordinance No 230Ord

An Ordinance authorizing an appropriation for paying the Expenses of negotiating the sale of Bonds of the City of Albany Oregon in the amount of \$75,000.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows.

Section 1. That there be, and is hereby appropriated out of the funds derived from the sale of Bonds of the City of Albany Oregon the sum of (\$500⁰⁰) Five Hundred dollars for the purpose of paying, the expenses incurred in negotiating the sale of said Bonds of the City of Albany Oregon, in the amount of (\$75,000⁰⁰), Seventy five thousand dollars to J. W. Sturtevant of San Francisco California

Section 2. That the Recorder of the City of Albany Oregon is hereby authorized, and directed to draw a city warrant for the sum of (\$500⁰⁰) Five Hundred dollars in favor of C. G. Burdett in payment of the expenses incurred in the sale of city Bonds, as provided for in Section one of this ordinance.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor.

Passed by the Council on Oct 27th 1891.

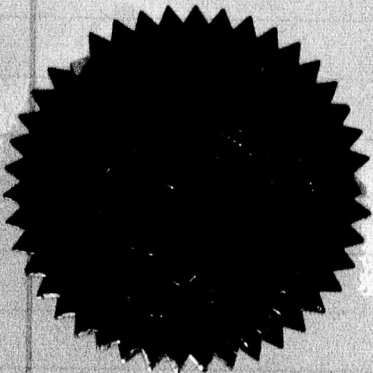
