

Ordinance No. 241.

Ord 241
 Are Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany Oregon to enter into and sign a contract in writing with the "Waterous Engine works Company of St. Paul Minnesota" for the purchase of (600) six hundred feet of rubber hose for the use of the Fire Department of the City of Albany Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor and Recorder of the City of Albany Oregon, are hereby authorized, directed, and empowered to enter into and sign on behalf of the City of Albany Oregon, written articles of agreement with the "Waterous Engine works Company of St. Paul Minnesota", for (600) six hundred feet of rubber fire hose for the use of the Fire Department of the City of Albany Oregon, upon the terms and conditions offered and proposed in a proposal submitted to the Common Council of the City of Albany by said "Waterous Engine works Company of St. Paul Minnesota", at a regular meeting of said Council held April 12th 1892, and accepted by said Council April 16th 1892.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the Mayor
