

Ordinance No 258

An Ordinance Providing for the Protection from injury and for the Preservation of the Steel Wagon Bridge over the Willamette River at the Northern Terminus of Calapooia Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows.

Section 1 That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to in any manner injure, deface, write or print upon or post any written or printed matter of any kind upon the steel wagon bridge over the Willamette River at the Northern Terminus of Calapooia Street in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, or to willfully ride or drive over said bridge at a greater speed than a walk, or to drive at any one time more than twenty head of cattle, horses, or mules, or more than one hundred head of sheep over said bridge or to drive any animal over said bridge at a speed greater than a walk, or to ride a bicycle, tricycle, or velocipede past any animal or team when passing over said bridge, or to climb, or lie, upon any part of the structure of said bridge above the floor thereof.

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court of said city be fined not less than ten dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or be imprisoned in the City jail not less than five days nor more than fifty days.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor
