

Ordinance No. 362.

An ordinance establishing the grade of Second Street from the East line of Main Street to the West line of Pine Street, and of Oak Street, and Sherman Street from the North line of the Salem road to the South line of First Street in the City of Albany, Oregon, and to repeal all former ordinances in so far only as they relate to the grade of that portion of said Second, Oak, and Sherman streets above specified.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The established grade of Second street from the East line of Main Street to the West line of Pine street, and of Oak street, and of Sherman streets from the North line of the Salem road to the South line of First street, shall be in conformity to the survey and plat made by City Surveyor W. B. Barr, in the year 1892, as directed and ordered by Resolution Number 36, adopted by the Common Council of said city at a regular meeting of said council held July, 12, 1892, and filed in the office of the Recorder of said city July 16, 1892.

Section 2: Gutter of streets to be twelve (12) feet from line of blocks abutting thereto.

Section 3: The center of finished street shall conform to the established grade, the gutters to be eight (8) tenths of a foot lower than the center of the street, and there shall be not less than six (6) inches of gravel in the center of the street, and not less than three (3) inches of gravel at the edge of the gutter.

Section 4: All water mains or pipes laid in the street shall be placed not less than two (2) feet below the level of the surface or top of street gutter.

Section 5: All gas mains or pipes laid in the street shall be placed not less than three (3) feet below the level of the surface of the top of the Street grade.

Section 6: The underground sewers shall be laid so that the top of the sewer shall be not less than three (3) feet below the level of the top of Street grade.

Section 7: The top of the sidewalk to be made even with the top of the grade of the center of the street, and shade trees hereafter planted or set out to be located not less than ten (10) feet from the edge of street on line of block abutting thereto.

Section 8: No water, sewer, gas, or other mains or pipes shall be laid in the street by any person, or persons, or firm or corporation, for rent, hire, domestic, or sanitary purposes, without the right or permit to lay such mains or pipes, is granted by Ordinance passed by the Common Council of the City of Albany.

Section 9: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith in so far only as they relate to the grade of that portion of the streets hereinbefore named and specified in this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 10: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
