Ord. No. 322 An Ordinance, Authorizing, Directing, and Empowering the Mayor, and Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, to enter into, and sign written Articles of Agreement with the "Albany Iron Works," of Albany, Oregon, for making repairs, and improvements to the City Jail.

The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the Mayor, and Recorder, of the City of Albany, Oregon, be, and they are hereby authorized, directed, and empowered, to enter into and sign written articles of agreement, with the "Albany Iron Works," of Albany, Oregon, for making certain repairs, and improvements to the city Jail of said City, such repairs, and improvements, to be made in accordance, with the plans, and specifications, heretofore adopted, and approved by the City Council, and now on file in the Office of the City Recorder; the price to be paid to the "Albany Iron Works," to be (\$485.00), Four Hundred, and Eighty-five Dollars, for the work complete, including all material, fixtures, and labor.

Section 2: That this ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
