

An Ordinance to prohibit the riding of Bicycles, Tricycles, or Velocipedes on the sidewalks, on certain streets in the City of Albany, Oregon, and to regulate the riding of the same on the sidewalks and streets, and over the Wagon Bridge across the Willamette river, in said city

Ord. No. 337

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1: That it shall at all times be unlawful for any person, or persons, to ride a Bicycle, Tri-cycle, or Velocipede, on the following described sidewalks, in the City of Albany, Oregon, to wit: On the sidewalk on First or Second Streets from Washington Street to West line of Perry Street, and on First or Second Streets from the East line of Perry Street, to the West line of Baker Street, or on Broadalbin, Ellsworth, and Lyon Streets, or the west side of Perry Street from the South line of Second Street, to North line of First Street, or on the East line of Lyon Street, from Second Street, to Ninth Street; That, it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride a Bicycle, Tri-cycle, or Velocipede, on any sidewalk in said City of Albany, from the 15th day of May to the 1st day of October of each and every year; Provided that, cripples using a Bicycle, Tri-cycle, or Velocipede for purpose of travel, shall be exempt from the provisions of this ~~Ordinance~~ Section.

Section 2: That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons, to ride a Bicycle, Tri-cycle, or Velocipede - over the Steel Wagon Bridge across the Willamette River in said City, at a greater rate of speed than four miles an hour, or on any sidewalk in said City at a greater rate of speed than six miles an hour, or on any Street in said City at a greater rate of speed than eight miles an hour, or to ride a Bicycle, Tri-cycle, or Velocipede at any time on any sidewalk in said City carelessly or negligently, or at such a rate of speed, or in such a manner, as to interfere with the free use of said sidewalks, by pedestrians.

Section 3: That it shall be unlawful for any person, or persons

To ride a Bicycle, Tri-cycle, or Velocipede, in said city during the night time without a head light being placed, and displayed, in a conspicuous manner, and in plain view on such bicycle, tri-cycle, or Velocipede; night time, in this ordinance, shall be, and is hereby deemed and declared to be from the first day of September to the first day of April of each year, from seven o'clock P.M. to sunrise, and from the first day of April, to the first day of September of each year from nine o'clock P.M. to sunrise.

Section 4: That, any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall, upon conviction thereof, before the Recorder's Court of said city, be fined not less than five dollars nor more than thirty dollars, or be imprisoned in the city jail not less than two days nor more than fifteen days.

Section 5: That, all ordinances, or parts of ordinances, in conflict herewith, be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect, and be in full force from, and after its approval by the Mayor.
