

ORDINANCE No. 385

An Ordinance prohibiting the maintaining, operating, or playing of nickel-in-the-slot machines or other devices of like character and to provide a punishment for the violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section I: - That any person or persons who shall conduct, maintain or operate, either as owner or owners, proprietor or proprietors, lessee or lessees, employee or employees, agent or agents, or who shall play or use any nickel-in-the-slot machine or other device of like character wherein there enters any element of chance, whether the same be played for money, checks, credits, or other thing representative of value; shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder's Court shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail for not less than two days nor more than fifty days or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section II: - In all prosecutions under this act for the conducting, maintaining or operating any such machine or device, proof of the possession of such machine or device or of permitting the same to be or remain in any public place under the control of the person so prosecuted, convenient for use, shall be prima facie evidence against such person of the violation of this ordinance.

Section III: - This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Mayor.
