An Ordinance to license, tax and regulate certain business in the City of Albany, Oregon, and to provide for the manner of issuing licenses, and providing a penalty for the violation thereof.

The People of the City of Albany, Oregon, do ordain as follows:—

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to sell, offer or attempt to sell goods or merchandise by selling trading stamps, checks or tickets or other thing of whatever name, to merchants, the same by such merchant being delivered to customers upon the purchase of goods and merchandise, and then exchanged by such customers with the person selling such trading stamps, checks, tickets or other thing of whatever name for his goods or merchandise, without first paying into the city treasury the sum of \$300.00 and upon receipt showing such payment procuring a license issued by the City Recorder authorizing the same. Such license shall be issued for the period of twelve months.

Sec. 2. Any merchant or peddler, in or near any trading stamps, checks or tickets mentioned in Section 1. of this ordinance must also first pay into the City treasury the sum of \$100.00 and upon receipt showing such payment procure a license issued by the City Recorder authorizing the same. Such license shall be issued for the period of twelve months.

Sec. 3. Any person found guilty of any violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a fine in any sum not exceeding \$100.00 or to imprisonment in the city jail not to exceed thirty days, or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
