

ORDINANCE NO. 414

Granting to Southern Pacific Company franchise to erect oil tank -

An ordinance to grant to the Oregon & California Railroad Company and Southern Pacific Company, lessee their successors and assigns, permission to construct, operate and maintain oil storage and delivery tanks for the use of said companies in the City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany, do ordain as follows:
Section 1. That there is and is hereby granted unto the Oregon & California Railroad Company and unto the Southern Pacific Company, its lessee, then successors and assigns, the right and privilege to construct, maintain and operate within the City of Albany an oil storage tank of the capacity of five thousand barrels for the storage of crude petroleum, and an oil delivery tank of the capacity of 28,500 gallons for the delivery of crude petroleum to the cars and engines of said companies or either thereof, their successors and assigns, which said tanks are to be located upon the grounds and right of way of said Oregon & California Railroad Co. in the City of Albany as shown upon blue print hereto attached and make a part hereof.

Passed the Council March 13 1906.
This ordinance having been delivered to the Mayor as required by law, and not having been returned by him within ten days, becomes a law as if he had approved it. Filed March 24, 1906.
