

## ORDINANCE NO. 450

## Relating to paving Elsworth Street

An Ordinance to ascertain, determine and declare the probable cost of certain proposed improvements which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 17, adopted by said Council on the second day of July, 1908, to make on Elsworth Street in said City from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street; To ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportional share of such probable cost of such improvements of said Elsworth Street that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof, adjacent to said part of Elsworth Street to be so improved; To direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of such assessment in the books of City Lists, as provided by the Charter of said City, and to declare an emergency;

Whereas, on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June, 1908, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a Resolution requiring the City Engineer of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of Elsworth Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street in said City with Bitulithic Pavement, and for the construction of concrete curbing, wherever necessary, and for the installing of a proper drainage system and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Elsworth Street, and the probable cost thereof, and requiring that such plans, specifications, estimates and probable cost be filed in the City Recorder's Office of said City, on or before the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1908, said Resolution being endorsed "Resolution No. 13," and adopted on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June, 1908; and

Whereas, The City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution No. 13, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said Resolution, for the said improvement of said Elsworth Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 13, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office of the said City of Albany, on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1908, endorsed "City Engineer plans and specifications for the improvement of the following named streets, to-wit: First Street from the East curb line of



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Washington Street to the West curb line of Lyon Street, Ferry Street from the North curb line of Second Street, to the South line of First Street; Broadalbin Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street; Eleventh Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street, and the estimate of the work to be done on each of said streets separately, and the probable cost thereof on each of said streets separately; and

Whereas, the said City Council, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of July 1905, by Resolution No. 17, duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said Council proposed to improve Eleventh Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street in the manner provided in the said Resolution No. 17, and

Whereas, in and by said Resolution No. 17, adopted as aforesaid by said Council, the City Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of the said proposed improvement of said Eleventh Street from the North curb line of Second Street to the South line of First Street, as provided by the Charter of the City of Albany; and

Whereas, the City Recorder, in pursuance of said order and direction of said City Council of said City of Albany, did duly give notice of the said proposed improvement of said Eleventh Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City; and

Whereas, said Council, in and by said Resolution No. 17, ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Eleventh Street, to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Eleventh Street to be improved as mentioned in said Resolution No. 17, to be the sum of \$2820.39, and the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Eleventh Street to be the sum of \$3128.69;

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Eleventh Street in the City of Albany, Albany, from the North curb line of Second Street to



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The South line of First Street, in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of said City of Albany, in and by said Resolution No. 17, is hereby declared to be the sum of \$3128.69.

Section 2. That the proportionate share of the said probable cost of said improvement of said Elsworth Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Elsworth Street to be improved aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 17, is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each such lot or part thereof, as follows:

Description of each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement of said Elsworth Street.

## Elsworth Street, East Side, Block No. 7.

J. K. Weatherford: Lot No. 1, in Block No. 7, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, 102 feet on Elsworth Street, assessed at \$611.00  
Also proportionate share of the cost of pavement of Elsworth Street abutting the alley, East side, assessed at \$47.05  
Total \$658.05

J. K. Weatherford & A. F. Smith:  
Lot No. 8, and West 1/2 of Lot No. 7, Block No. 7, in City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, 102 feet on Elsworth Street, assessed at \$611.00  
Also proportionate share of the cost of paving Elsworth Street abutting the alley, East side, assessed at \$63.20  
Total \$674.20

Proportionate share of the cost of pavement abutting the alley on East side of Elsworth Street assessed against the following described property, to wit:

Mrs. Maggie Sullivan: The West 1/2 of Lot No. 5, in Block No. 7, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, 22 feet assessed at \$15.45

The East 1/2 of Lot No. 7, in Block No. 7, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, 45 feet assessed at \$31.60



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Frank Shipton: The East 2/3 of Lot No. 7 in Block No. 7 in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, "44 feet" assessed at \$30.90

Ellsworth Street West side, "Block No. 8,"

Lot No. 4 in Block No. 8 in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, 102 feet on Ellsworth Street assessed at \$611.00  
Also proportionate share of the cost of paving Ellsworth Street abutting the alley on West side, assessed at \$47.05

Lot 5, and East 2/3 of Lot No. 6 in Block No. 8, in the City of Albany, Linn County, Oregon, 102 feet on Ellsworth Street assessed at \$611.00  
Also proportionate share of the cost of pavement abutting on the alley on West side of Ellsworth Street, assessed at \$62.50  
Total \$673.50

The West 2/3 of Lot No. 3, in Block No. 8, in the City of Albany Linn County, Oregon, "44 feet" assessed at \$30.90

Charles Pfeiffer:  
First Street property abutting on alley to wit:  
The East 2/3 of Lot 3, in Block No. 8, in Albany Linn County, Oregon, "23 feet", assessed at \$16.15

Section 3, The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, is hereby ordered and directed to immediately enter a statement of the assessment made and declared by this Ordinance, together with the names of the respective owners of each lot or part thereof herein above described in the book of City Liens of the said City of Albany, as provided in the Charter of said City.



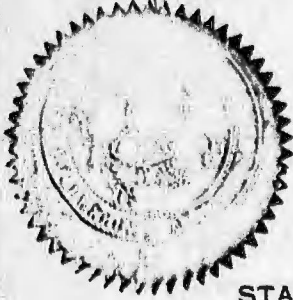
