

ORDINANCE NO. 471

Granting the Albany Preserving Company Right of Way across Jackson St

An ordinance granting the Albany Preserving Co. the right of way for a railroad track across Jackson Street for the City of Albany, Oregon.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the Albany Preserving Company, and its assigns, is hereby granted the right of way for a railroad track connecting with the rail road track of the Southern Pacific Company at a point on and near the North line of Block 10 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and running thence westerly across Jackson Street in said City and upon the premises of said Albany Preserving Company and near the North line of Block 17 in said Addition together with the right to run cars and trains over and upon said track: said Company and its successors and assigns to have, use and enjoy said right of way as long as they shall use the same for the proper operation of trains and cars over and upon the same.

Section 2. That said Albany Preserving Company, as long as it uses said right of way over and across said Jackson Street, shall keep the said track in good repair and shall plank its track across said Jackson Street from curb line to curb line in the space between the rails and for a space of twelve inches from said rails outward, which said plank shall be spaced flush with the top of the rails so as to least obstruct travel by the public, and said City hereby expressly reserves the right to establish the grade of said street, to prescribe the manner in which side walks shall be constructed at all crossings of said rail way track, the side walks at such crossings to be built and kept in repair by and at the expense of said Company, the said railway track to be so constructed as not to obstruct travel on the street over which it passes.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect to be in full force from and after 30 days from its approval by the Mayor
