

ORDINANCE No. 517

Age Ordinance prohibiting the throwing of Confetti or other material of a similar character upon any person on the streets of the City of Albany, Oregon, and providing for the punishment thereof.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That any person who shall upon the streets within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, throw upon any person, Confetti, or other material of a similar character, or who shall thrust a feather duster in any persons face, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before the Recorder Court of said City, be punished by a fine of not less than five, nor more than fifty dollars, or by imprisonment in the city jail not less than two days, nor more than twenty-five days, or both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the Court.

Section 2. In as much as the peace, health and safety of the City depends, that this Ordinance become immediately operative, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
