

Declaring a surplus, paving Ferry Street from 1st to Water St.

An Ordinance declaring a surplus on account of Street Paving, by the Warren Construction Company, of a surplus on Ferry street from First to Water street, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany, to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said part of Ferry street and heretofore assessed for making such improvement, and entered upon the docket of City liens of the City of Albany, Oregon, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of eleven and 16 hundredths per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and the Warren Construction Company, for the improvement of Ferry Street, from the north line of First street to the north curb line of Water Street, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said street, and heretofore assessed for making such improvement, as their several interests may appear.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, is hereby directed to enter in the docket of City liens, in the surplus column thereof, a credit of eleven and 16 hundredths per cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein, to defray the cost of the improvement of said portion of said Ferry street; said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate, in sums as follows, to-wit:-
