

## Declaring a surplus for paving Washington Street.

Ord 555. An Ordinance, declaring a surplus on account of paving of street by the "Marble Construction Company" a surplus on Washington Street, from the South line of First for paving street, to the North curb line of Ninth street, and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate, abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of Washington Street, heretofore assessed and entered on record in the Docket of City Liens of the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such improvement, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of nine and one third per-cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and the "Marble Construction Company," for the improvement of Washington Street, from the South line of First Street, to the North curb line of Ninth Street, and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate, abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said Washington Street, heretofore assessed for making such improvement, as their several interests may appear.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon is hereby directed to enter in the docket of City Liens, in the Surplus Column thereof, a credit of nine and one third per-cent, based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein, to defray the cost of the improvement of said Washington Street; said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate, and in sum as follows, to-wit:-
