

ORDINANCE No. 560

The Extension of the City Boundaries

Ord 560
Ordinance
of the City
of Albany

An Ordinance providing for the holding of a special election on the 15th day of January 1912 within the City of Albany, Oregon and also within certain territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Albany, Oregon, for the purpose of submitting to the legal voters of said City of Albany and also the voters of said territory the question whether said territory shall be annexed to and become a portion of the corporate limits of the City of Albany, designates and appoints officers of said special election within said City and also within said territory, provides the manner and place of holding said special election both within said City and within said territory, and prescribes the manner of making return of the result of said election to the Council.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:
Section 1. That in the manner provided by law and as hereinafter provided and for the purpose hereinafter set forth, a special election shall be held on the 15th day of January 1912 within the City of Albany, Oregon and also within the following described territory, to-wit:

Commencing in the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River at a point North 1°35' West of the Northeast corner of the Donation Land Claim of Abram Hackleman, Notification No. 699 and claim No. 62 in Township 11, South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Linn County, Oregon and running thence South 1°35' East to the Northeast corner of the above named Donation Land Claim, thence South 1°35' East to a point on the East boundary line of said claim where the south line of Ninth Street in the City of Albany, Oregon if extended eastward on a straight line, would intersect said claim line, thence Westward and parallel with the North boundary line of Ninth Street, if extended, to a point 66 feet South of the Southeast corner of Block 7 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, thence Southwesterly in a straight line to the Southeast corner of Block 96 in Monteith's Southern Addition to the City of Albany, thence Westward and parallel with the South boundary line of 11th Street to the Southwest corner of Block 105 in Monteith's Southern Addition.

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to said City of Albany, thence Northerly along the East line of Elm Street to the North line of Ninth Street in said City of Albany, thence Westerly along the said North line of Ninth Street to the South west corner of Block 61 in said City of Albany, thence North 9° West to the center of Calapooia Creek, thence down the center of said creek with the meanderings thereof to the West line of Maple Street, thence on a Northerly direction on the West line of Maple Street, if extended, to the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River, thence Westerly following the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River to its point of intersection with the Northerly extension of the West line of Walnut Street in said City of Albany, thence Southerly on said Northerly extension of said West line of said Walnut Street to the North bank of the Calapooia Creek, thence following the North bank of said Calapooia Creek up stream to a point due North of the Northwest corner of the Maroonie Cemetery as said Cemetery is described upon the plat thereof recorded on page 16 in Book 1 of Plats in the office of the County Recorder of Linn County, Oregon, thence Southerly following the West line of said Maroonie Cemetery if produced to the Southwest corner thereof, thence South to the North line of Hazelwood Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence Westerly on the North line of said Hazelwood Addition to the East line of Gale Street in said Addition, thence Southerly on the East line of said Gale Street to the South line of St. George Avenue in said Addition, thence Westerly on the South line of said St. George Avenue to the East line of Hop Street in said Addition, thence Southerly on said East line of said Hop Street and on the southerly extension thereof to the North line of the County road leading from Albany to Corvallis in said County, thence Westerly following the North line of said County road to the point where the same intersects the section line between sections 12 and 13 in Township 11, North, Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian Oregon, thence East on said section line to the East line of the County road leading from Albany to Tangent in said County, thence South 40 rods, thence East to the section line between sections 17 and 18 in Township 11, South Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, thence North on said section line to the North line of the County

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road running along the South line of said Donation Land Claim of A. Hackleman in said Township and Range, thence Easterly on the North line of said last mentioned road to its intersection with the West line of the County road running along the East line of what is known as Hackleman's Grove adjoining the present City of Albany, Oregon, thence Northerly on the West line of said last mentioned County road to the South line of the right of way of the Corvallis and Eastern Railroad, thence Easterly on the South line of said right of way to the East line of the Donation Land Claim of L. G. Curkhart in said Township and Range, thence Northerly on the East line of said Donation Land Claim to the Easterly projection of the North line of River Street in Woodlin's Addition to the City of Albany, thence Westerly on said projection of said North line of said River Street to the East line of said Woodlin's Addition to the City of Albany, thence Northerly following the East line of said Woodlin's Addition, if extended, to the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River, thence Westerly following the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River to the place of beginning.

Commencing at 9 o'clock in the morning and continuing until 6:30 o'clock in the evening of the same day without closing the paths.

Section 2. That said special election shall be conducted, except as herein otherwise provided, both within said City and within said territory in the same manner as general elections are held in said City.

Section 3. That the following places are hereby designated as polling places within said City of Albany for holding said special election in the several wards.

At County Recorder's Office for first ward.

At City Recorder's Office for second ward.

At the Kurtz Lumber Company's office for third ward.

Section 4. That the following places are hereby designated as polling places in the above described territory for holding said special election to-wit:

At room adjoining Lumber Store Cor. 9th & Elm Sts.
Crum's River Building on Centre road.

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Section 5. That the following persons are hereby designated and appointed judges and clerks of said election in the several wards within said City, as follows:

W. B. Turner, O. W. Warren, Rufus Thompson, Judges for First Ward.
 H. F. Merrill, E. Washburn, Clerks for First Ward.
 J. J. Bates, P. A. Lawson, W. C. Tweedale Judges for Second Ward.
 M. Sanders, E. C. Brandberry, Clerks for Second Ward.
 H. W. McElmurry, N. O'Leary, J. J. Livingston, Judges for Third Ward.
 A. W. Bowman and E. L. Humphrey, Clerks for Third Ward.

Section 6. That the following persons are hereby designated and appointed judges and clerks of said election in the territory above described

Thos. Ligh. Wm Morgan, North Houston, Judges at Lumpkin's Store, Corner 9th + Elm and Earl Fisher and C. H. Weider Clerks at Lumpkin's store.

H. D. Hackleman, Geo Wilho, J. A. Willard, Judges.
 W. C. Burkhardt and E. J. Lephant Clerks at Prune Bliver Building on Louisiana Road.

Section 7. All persons entitled to the privilege of an elector in the City of Albany Oregon, according to the Constitution and laws of Oregon and the charter of Albany, shall be qualified to vote at said special election.

Section 8. All persons entitled to the privilege of an elector of the State of Oregon, according to the Constitution and laws of Oregon and who is actually residing in said territory above described shall be qualified to vote within said territory at said special election.

Section 9. That at said special election the following question shall be submitted to the legal voters of said above described territory, to-wit:

Shall the following described territory be annexed to the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon, to-wit:

Commencing in the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River at a point North $1^{\circ}35'$ West of the Northwest corner of the Donation Land Claim of Abram Hackleman, Notification No. 699 and Claim No. 62 in Township 11, South, Range 3 West of the Willamette Meridian, in Linne County, Oregon and running thence South $1^{\circ}35'$ East to the Northeast corner of the above named Donation Land Claim, thence South $1^{\circ}35'$ East to a point on the East boundary line of said Claim where the South line of Ninth Street in the City of Albany

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Oregon, if extended eastward on a straight line, would intersect said Claim line, thence Westerly and parallel with the North boundary line of Ninth Street, if extended, to a point 66 feet South of the Southeast corner of Block 7 in Hackleman's Second Addition to the City of Albany, thence Southwesterly in a straight line to the Southeast corner of Block 96 in Monteth's Southern Addition to the City of Albany, thence Westerly and parallel with the South boundary line of 11th Street to the Southwest corner of Block 105 in Monteth's Southern Addition to said City of Albany, thence Northerly along the East line of Elm Street to the North line of Ninth Street in said City of Albany, thence Westerly along the said North line of Ninth Street to the Southwest corner of Block 61 in said City of Albany, thence North 9^o West to the center of Calapooia Creek, thence down the center of said Creek with the meanderings thereof to the West line of Maple Street, thence in a Northerly direction on the West line of Maple Street, if extended, to the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River, thence Westerly following the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River to its point of intersection with the Northerly extension of the West line of Walnut Street in said City of Albany, thence Southerly on said Northerly extension of said West line of said Walnut Street to the North bank of the Calapooia Creek, thence following the North bank of said Calapooia Creek up stream to a point three North of the Northwest corner of the Masonic Cemetery as said Cemetery is described upon the plat thereof recorded on page 16 in Book 11 of Plats in the office of the County Recorder of Linn County, Oregon, thence Southerly following the West line of said Masonic Cemetery if produced to the Southwest corner thereof, thence South to the North line of Hazelwood Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence Westerly on the North line of said Hazelwood Addition to the East line of Sale Street in said Addition, thence Southerly on the East line of said Sale Street to the South line of St. George Avenue in said Addition, thence Westerly on the South line of the said St. George Avenue to the East line of Hay Street

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in said Addition, thence Southerly on said East line of said Day Street and on the Southerly extension thereof to the North line of the County road leading from Albany to Corvallis in said County, thence Westerly following the North line of said County road to the point where the same intersects the section line between sections 12 and 13 in Township 11, South Range 4 West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, thence East on said section line to the East line of the County road leading from Albany to Tangent in said County, thence South 40 rods, thence East to the section line between sections 17 and 18 in Township 11, South, Range 3, West of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, thence North on said section line to the North line of the County road running along the South line of said Donation Land Claim of A. Hackleman in said Township and Range, thence Easterly on the North line of said East mentioned road to its intersection with the West line of the County road running along the East line of what is known as Hackleman's Groves adjoining the present City of Albany, Oregon, thence Northerly on the West line of said East mentioned County road to the South line of the right of way of the Corvallis and Eastern Railroad, thence Easterly on the South line of said right of way to the East line of the Donation Land Claim of L. C. Burkhardt in said Township and Range, thence Northerly on the East line of said Donation Land Claim to the Easterly projection of the North line of River Street in Woodliss Addition to the City of Albany, thence Westerly on said projection of said North line of said River Street to the East line of said Woodliss Addition to the City of Albany, thence Northerly following the East line of said Woodliss Addition if extended, to the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River, thence Westerly following the middle of the main channel of the Willamette River to the place of beginning.

Section 10. That the City Recorder of Albany shall give notice of such special election in the name of the City Council in the manner prescribed by law.

Section 11. The City Recorder of Albany shall cause to be printed a sufficient number of ballots containing a description of said territory proposed to be annexed to the corporate limits of Albany and a form to vote

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For Enumeration and Against Enumeration, and shall supply a sufficient number of ballots for each polling place both within said City and within said territory and shall also supply poll books, ink, pencils, pens, stationery and other proper and necessary supplies for said election both within said city and within said territory and the City Marshal shall install voting booths in said polling places both within said city and within said territory and deliver the ballots, ballot boxes and other supplies to the said judges and clerks of election at said polling places both within said city and within said territory in due time for their use by the voters, judges and clerks and others interested in said special election at the time of holding same.

Section 12. On or before 12 o'clock noon of the 22nd day of January 1912 returns of said special election shall be filed with the recorder of Albany, Oregon.

Section 13. Whereas conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the public peace, health and safety, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its approval by the mayor.
