

ORDINANCE NO. 582.

An ordinance to provide for the
continuance of the City of Albany, Oregon, and to amend
all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith;

The Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, do hereby ordain:

Section 1. The Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall
receive as compensation for his services a salary of One
thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) per annum, which shall be paid
monthly out of the City Treasury, and no other claim against
the City shall be allowed.

Section 2. Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict
with the provisions of this Ordinance, passed on or after
the 29th day of April, 1912, shall be null and void.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and amend
all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith
passed on or after the 29th day of April, 1912.
