Ordinance to license and regulate hawkers and peddlers within the City of Albany, Oregon, and defining what shall constitute a hawker and a peddler and prescribing all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

The People of the City of Albany Ordains as follows:

Section 1. Hawkers shall pay a license of \$50.00 per day for each day they shall conduct their business within the corporate limits of the City of Albany, Oregon. Any person who offers goods for sale by walking upon the streets, and is deemed a hawker within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section 2. Peddlers shall be classified and rated as follows:

When traveling with two or more horses, first class.

When traveling with one horse, second class.

When traveling on foot, third class.

Peddlers of the first class shall pay a license of \$10.00 per month, or \$25.00 per quarter.

Peddlers of the second class shall pay a license of \$12.00 per month, or \$25.00 per quarter.

Peddlers of the third class shall pay a license of \$10.00 per month, or \$25.00 per quarter, provided that no peddler shall be permitted to travel from place to place on first street from Barney to Calapooia Streets; on second street from Calapooia Street to 10th street and from 10th street to 12th street; and no peddler shall be permitted to use the sidewalk in front or adjacent to any property within the City of Albany, except by the consent of the occupants of such property.

Section 3. Any person who shall use or sell at retail, books, newspapers, notions, pictures, wares, parts, wares or commodities of any kind upon the streets, or traveling from place to place in the City of Albany shall be deemed and regarded a peddler under this ordinance. Provided, that this ordinance shall not apply to persons offering for sale, or selling newspapers, books or religious tracts or to farmers, gardeners or husbandmen selling the products of their farms, gardens, or milk ranches, and provided further that a permit may be issued to any peddler of the third class, who may be physically unable to perform manual labor, or to any person residing in this City, who by

peddlers maintain, either himself or family or both, such permit to be issued by the City Recorder, upon the application for such permit being with the Recorder a recommendation, signed by the council, the ordinance, authorizing and directing the Recorder to issue such permit.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the above are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Any person or persons violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be liable to a fine of not more than five dollars, or imprisonment in the City jail not more than two days, nor more than two days.

Section 6. Whereas, existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
