

Ordinance No. 1013

An ordinance declaring a surplus ^{in account} of street paving by the "Warren Construction Company," on Fourth Street from the east line of Washington Street to the west curb line of Main Street; and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of Fourth Street heretofore assessed and entered of record in the books of City Liens in the City of Albany, Oregon, for making such improvement, their proportionate share of such surplus.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of .08474 per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into and between the City of Albany, Oregon, and the "Warren Construction Company," for the improvement of Fourth Street from the east line of Washington Street to the west curb line of Main Street and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate abutting upon and adjacent to said portion of said Fourth Street heretofore assessed for making such improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the Book of City Liens in the surplus column thereof, a credit of .08474 per cent based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said Fourth Street; said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, owners or reputed owners of such various parcels of real estate and in sum as follows, to-wit:

Whereas conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
