An ordinance granting to F. G. Will the use of a certain portion of First Street to erect and maintain a public street clock.

Whereas F. G. Will has applied to the council for permission to erect and maintain on First Street in the City of Albany, a public street clock, the same to be illuminated at night time, which clock will enable the residents of the City of Albany to readily ascertain the time, either day or night; and

Whereas said clock will be a public benefit and will be used by the public in general;

Therefore;

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The right is hereby granted to F. G. Will to erect and maintain a public street clock in front of the said F. G. Will's place of business No. 324 West First Street in Albany. The same to be erected on an iron post at the outer edge of the sidewalk, the base of said post to be not over 24 inches in diameter and the top of the clock on said post to be not less than 10 feet above the sidewalk. Said post to be set and placed to the satisfaction and approval of the committee on streets and public property. Provided however should the said public clock not be kept illuminated at night or should the same fail to show the correct time of day for a period of five days, then the same upon demand of the council of the City of Albany shall be forthwith removed.
