

ORDINANCE NO. 690

REVISED ALBANY DESIGN

Ord 690

An ordinance providing for the time and manner of building and constructing a lateral sewer through Block 3 in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, into Baker Street to connect to the main sewer to be constructed on Baker Street, providing how the cost of said improvement shall be paid and the penalty and damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making the improvement if the same be not completed within the time as herein provided and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work and contract and providing for the giving of the Recorder of the City of Albany of proper notice for bid for the making of said improvement.

The Ordinance of the City of Albany shall read as follows:

Section 1. That there shall be constructed a six inch vitrified terra cotta sewer through Block 3 in the Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, and into Baker Street to connect with the main sewer to be constructed on Baker Street.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans and specifications of the City Engineer of said City for the construction of said sewer line in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on the 10th day of September, 1913.

The cost of said lateral sewer from the east line of said Block to the connection with the main sewer on Baker Street shall be paid by the City of Albany out of the general fund of said City; the remaining portion of the cost of said improvement shall be paid out of the fund established and arising out of the assessments heretofore made as contained and increased by ordinance No. 689 passed by the council of the City of Albany on the 20th day of September, 1913, as the lots and parts of lots in said Block 3 and especially and in part thereof which have been rejected hereby are provided by the charter of the City of Albany.

The said sewer shall be completed by the 1st day of November, 1913.

All bids for the making of said improvement deemed unreasonable by the council of the City of Albany, may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City for the making of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement and at the time of signing said contract and be, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond with good and sufficient

sureties to be approved by the assessor of the City of Albany in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of all the conditions of said contract.

Section 2. If the same person or corporation enters into any contract with the city of Albany to make said improvement shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of three dollars for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor during the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of the completion of said improvement is extended by the council.

Section 3. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give public notice for the making of said improvement by publishing notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in said city of Albany fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement.
