An ordinance to amend Section Six of Ordinance No. 161 entitled "An ordinance defining and prescribing the duties and qualifications and fixing the compensation of City Treasurer passed by the Council August 16, 1887, approved August 23, 1887, as amended by Ordinance No. 274 of the City of Albany.

The People of the City of Albany do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section Six of Ordinance No. 161 entitled "An ordinance defining and prescribing the duties and qualifications and fixing the compensation of City Treasurer" passed by the Council August 16, 1887, approved by the Mayor August 23, 1887, as amended by Ordinance No. 274 be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Section 2. The City Treasurer shall receive as his salary the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per annum, and shall be paid quarterly to the Treasurer, the same as other claims against the City.
