An ordinance declaring it unlawful for any person to carry, sell, or transport any intoxicating liquor through the streets, alleys, or other public place in the City of Albany or at the original packages in which such intoxicating liquors are shipped into the City of Albany or at the place of sale.

As the carrying and conveying of intoxicating liquors through the streets, alleys and other public places of the City of Albany is a nuisance and a public nuisance in which such intoxicating liquors are carried into the City of Albany and in the course of such carrying and conveying of intoxicating liquor and of conveying same in violation of the laws of the State, quietude and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Albany,

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. Any person or persons who shall carry, and through any street, alley, or place in other public place within the City of Albany any intoxicating liquors or any kind except the original packages in which such intoxicating liquors are shipped into the City of Albany, shall be deemed guilty of an infraction.

Section 2. Section 1 of this ordinance shall not be construed to prohibit the carrying, conveying or use of any pure alcohol for medicinal and domestic purposes, or for the use of any person or persons in the carrying, conveying or use of any pure alcohol as medicine, or for medicinal purposes in compliance with the Local, State or Federal laws of the State of Oregon.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of an infraction and shall be liable to a fine of not more than fifty dollars or to both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court and shall in case of the conviction shall be liable to the destruction of any intoxicating liquors found carried in violation of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.

Ordinance No. 726, to be known as the Ordinance relating to the carrying of intoxicating liquors through the streets, alleys and other public places of the City of Albany.

Existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance take effect as if in full force and effect from its approval by the Mayor.
