

Ordinance No. 1142

An ordinance declaring a surplus on account of the construction of a lateral sewer by George Gordon beginning at the main sewer in Geary Street and running westerly through the center of said Block 7 across Denver Street, through the center of Block 14 across Cleveland Street and 48 feet into Block 7 and directing the Recorder of the City of Albany to place to the credit of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate within said Blocks 7, 14, and portion of Block 7 in Haskellman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany heretofore assessed and entered of record in the books of City Taxes in the City of Albany, Oregon for making such improvement their proportionate share of such surplus:

The People of the City of Albany and Ordinance follows:

Section 1. That a surplus of 11.346 per cent is hereby ascertained and declared to exist upon the completion of the contract entered into by and between the City of Albany, Oregon and George Gordon for the construction of a lateral sewer beginning at the main sewer in Geary Street and running westerly through the center of said Block 7 across Denver Street, through the center of Block 14 across Cleveland Street and 48 feet into Block 7 all in Haskellman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon and in favor of the several owners of the various parcels of real estate within said Blocks 7, 14 and portion of Block 7 heretofore assessed for making such improvement.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to enter in the books of City Taxes in the surplus column thereof a credit of 11.346 per cent based upon the several amounts heretofore assessed and entered therein to defray the cost of the improvement of said lateral sewer; said surplus being in favor of the following named persons, or their or their legal heirs or assigns of parcels of real estate within said blocks and portion of Block 7:

Section 3. Whereas conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval by the Mayor.
