

An ordinance to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer, which the council of the City of Albany Oregon, has determined by Resolution 1,038 adopted by the council on the 14th day of October, 1914, beginning at the main sewer in Baker Street and running westerly through the center of Block Four, Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, across Lyon Street and through the center of Block 19 in the City of Albany, Oregon, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of such probable cost of such improvement that is assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement, to direct the Recorder of said city to enter a statement of such assessments in the Book of City Liens as provided by the Charter of said City.

Whereas on the 14th day of October, 1914, the council of the City of Albany duly adopted a resolution requiring the City Engineer of said city to make plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sewer beginning at the main sewer in Baker Street and running westerly through the center of Block Four, Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, across Lyon Street and through the center of Block 19 in the City of Albany, Oregon, and for the estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof and requiring such plans, specifications and estimates and probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of the City of Albany on said October 14th, 1914 and said resolution being on record Resolution 1,037, a copy of Oct. 14th 1914, and

Whereas the City Engineer of said City of Albany, pursuant to said Resolution 1,037, made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by said resolution for the construction of said sewer in the manner specified in said resolution, 1,037, and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's Office in said city on the 14th day of October, 1914; and

Whereas the said city council, on the 14th day of Oct. 1914 by Resolution 1,038 duly adopted by the council determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient and that said council determine to construct said lateral sewer beginning at the main sewer in Baker Street and running westerly through the center of Block Four, Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, across Lyon Street and through the center of Block 19 in the City of Albany, Oregon, as provided by the Charter of said City of Albany; and

Whereas the recorder in pursuance of said order and direction of the council of said City of Albany duly has entered in said Book of City Liens the assessments provided by the Charter of said City; and

Whereas the said council in said Resolution 1,038 has determined the probable cost of

making said improvement to be paid by the owners of the real property subject to said improvement as mentioned in said Resolution No. 38 to be the sum of \$7695.02 and the total probable cost of making said improvement to be \$898.77.

Therefore

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain As Follows:

Section 1. That a line in red vitrified terra cotta lateral sewer shall be laid beginning at the main sewer in Baker Street and running westerly through the center of Block 1008, Eastern Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, across Lyon Street and through the center of Block 7 in the City of Albany, Oregon.

and in accordance with said Resolution No. 38 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of Albany on the 4th day of Oct., 1911.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement in the manner heretofore determined by the council of said City of Albany in and by said Resolution No. 38 is hereby declared to be the sum of \$898.77 and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the property adjacent and especially and particularly benefited there by is the sum of \$7695.02.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement as assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said improvement as aforesaid and as determined by said council in and by said Resolution No. 38 is hereby ascertained and determined to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of each of said lots or parts thereof, as follows:
