

6. The ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving the same and for the public use of said street to the satisfaction of the City Council, providing however that no such improvement shall be made, the property of which is in the City, or any part thereof, by the person or persons making such improvements; and the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond, or other sufficient security, for the work, such improvement of a street or public place, and the giving of the Recorder of said City of proper notice for the same, or the completion of such improvement of said public street.

The said ordinance of said City is as follows:

Section 1. That said street from the North line of First Street to the north line of Third Street, here is improved in the following manner, to-wit:

- First: By grading said street to the proper subgrade.
- Second: By paving the roadway of said street with asphalt concrete pavement in an asphalt concrete construction.
- Third: By constructing catch basins.
- Fourth: By constructing inlets.
- Fifth: By laying of special sewer pipe.
- Sixth: By making curb-stones.

Said improvements to be made in accordance with the Charter and ordinances of the City of Chicago, as amended, and the specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City, or the improvement of said street from the North line of First Street to the North line of Third Street, and the estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom any contract may be entered into by the City of Albany for the construction of said improvement shall, before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City or its authorized officers and agents, with good and sufficient surety, in the sum of Fifteen Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. The person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of said Baker Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said city shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$25.00 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said city is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice to bids on the making of said improvement of said portion of said Baker Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Daily Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, and describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Baker Street.
