

Sawtooth Agency, Oregon

This Ordinance providing for the time and manner of improving Second Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Sherman Street, providing how the cost of such improvements shall be paid, the penalty or damage to the City of Albany by the person or persons making such improvements if the same shall not be completed within the time agreed upon, and the giving of a good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the work of such improvements of said part of said street and providing for the giving by the Recorder of said City of proper notice for and for the completion of said improvements of said part of said street.

The People of the City of Albany Do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That Second Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Sherman Street shall be improved in the following manner, to-wit:

First: By grading said street to the required grade and

Second: By grading said street six inches deep and eight feet wide.

Said improvement to be made in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, and the plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer of said City for the improvement of said street, filed in the office of the Recorder of said City of Albany, Oregon, on the 12th day of May, 1915, endorsed "Engineer's Plans for the improvement of Second Street from the east line of Main Street to the west line of Sherman Street and the estimate of the work to be done on said street and the probable cost there of."

The cost of said improvement of said portion of Second Street shall be paid out of the funds collected and arising upon and out of the assessments now or hereafter to be made, ascertained and declared by the Council of the City of Albany on the lots and parts of lots adjacent to said portion of said Second Street to be improved, and especially and particularly benefited thereby as provided by the charter of said city.

The said improvement of said portion of said Second Street shall be completed on the 1st day of August, 1915.

All bids for the making of said improvement of said street deemed unreasonable by the Council of the City of Albany may be rejected.

Any firm, person or corporation with whom a contract may be entered into by the City of Albany in the making of said im-

provement shall, before commencing said improvement, and at the time of signing such contract, make, execute and deliver to said City a good and sufficient bond, with good and sufficient surety, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars for the faithful performance of such contract.

Section 2. If the person, firm or corporation entering into any contract with the said City of Albany to make said improvement of Second Street shall not complete the same within the time mentioned and specified in said contract, said City shall be deemed to suffer damages on account thereof to the amount of \$2.50 per day for each and every day the completion of said work is delayed beyond the time stated in such contract, which amount shall be paid by such contractor doing the work at the completion thereof, unless the time of completion of said improvement is extended by the Council.

Section 3. The Recorder of said City is hereby ordered and directed to immediately give proper notice for bids for the making of said improvement of said portion of Second Street by publishing such notice ten days in the Albany Evening Herald, a daily newspaper published in the said City of Albany, fully describing in said notice the time and manner of doing the work of said improvement of said Second Street.
