

Approved by City of Albany
October 16, 1915.

Any ordinance to license, tax and regulate fortune-telling,
clairvoyance, palmistry and handwriting and providing a penalty for the
violation thereof.

Action 1. Every person who has a license in the business,
occupation, profession or vocation of Fortune-telling, clairvoyance,
palmistry or any business, occupation, profession or vocation of
like nature, shall first obtain from the City of Albany a license
therefor; provided that the fee required from every person for such
license shall be the sum of \$2.00 per month or the sum of \$2.50
per year.

Action 2. That if any person or persons exercising or carrying
on any business, profession, occupation or vocation for
which a license is required by this ordinance without first obtaining
such license as herein required, or violate any of the provi-
sions of this ordinance, he, she or they shall on conviction therefor
before the City Recorder, for every such offense besides being liable
for the punishment of the licensee, be subjected to a fine of not less
than \$3.00 nor more than \$25.00 or by imprisonment in the city
jail for a period of not less than two days nor more than 12 hours
or by both such fine and imprisonment at the discretion of
the court.

Action 3. Whereas this ordinance is necessary for
the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
safety, an emergency exists and an emergency is hereby de-
clared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force from
and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
