

An Ordinance imposing a tax for the City of Albany upon the assessment made in 1915, said tax to be collected in 1916.

The People of the City of Albany do Ordain as Follows:

Section 1. That a tax levy for the City of Albany upon the assessment made in 1915, said tax to be collected in 1916, be and the same is hereby made as follows:

General running expenses,	6.00 mills.
Interest on and reduction of warrant indebtedness,	2.00 mills.
Interest on bond indebtedness	1.85 mills.
Sinking fund, \$75,000 refunding bonds,	.45 mills.
\$22,000 City Hall Site bonds,	.15 mills.
\$19,000 Sewer bonds,	.15 mills.
\$1,000 Sewer bonds,	.05 mills.
Library fund,	.50 mills.
Interest on and sinking fund for proposed bond issue	1.35 mills.
Total	12.50 mills.

to be levied upon the equal assessed valuation of all assessable property, both real and personal, in said City of Albany as shown and appears upon the assessment roll of Linn County, made in the year 1915 with a valuation amounting to \$3,427,640.00, exclusive of property owned by public utilities to be assessed by the State Tax Commission and which has not been reported.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby ordered and directed to immediately notify the County Clerk and the County Assessor of the County of Linn in writing under the seal of said City of this levy.
