AN ORGINANCE TO AMEND SECTION I OF OR-DINANCE NO. 721 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND REGULATING THE FIRE DEPART-MENT OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, " PASSED BY THE COUNCIL ARRIL, 22, 1914 AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR APRIL, 25, 1914.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBARY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That section 1 of ordinance number 721 entitled "An ordinance creating and regulating the Fire department of the City of Albany," passed by the Council April 22, 1914 and approved by the Mayor April 25, 1914 be and the same is hereby made to read as follows; Section 1. That the Fire Department of the City of Albany shall consist of a chief engineer, and assistant engineer, president, secretary, treasurer, a board of control consisting of three members, one engineman, one auto driver, six call men, and such members as may hereafter be admitted by the by-laws and regulations of the department hereafter to be made, not to exceed one hundred members in all and shall be known as the "Albany Fire Department"
