

ORDINANCE NO. 222

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF OREGON ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, A CORPORATION, FOR THE VACATION OF THE ALLEY BETWEEN LOTS 2 AND 3, BLOCK 12, AND LOTS 4, 5 AND 6, BLOCK 12, ALBANY, OREGON.

This matter coming before the Council at its regular meeting on May 23, 1917, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock p. m., and it appearing that on April 13, 1917 the petition of the Oregon Electric Railway Company was filed with the City Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, praying for the vacation of the alley between lots two (2) and three (3), block twelve (12), and lots four (4), five (5) and six (6), block twelve (12), Albany, Oregon, and it further appearing that on April 13, 1917, due notice was given of the time and place of this hearing and of the pendency of said petition, said notices having been posted in three (3) of the most public places in the City of Albany, State of Oregon, containing a description of the property to be vacated, and due proof of the posting of said notices having been filed herein, and it further appearing that the consent of PORTLAND TRUST COMPANY OF OREGON, a corporation, and M. SENDERS AND COMPANY, a corporation, to said vacation has been filed herein and that the Oregon Electric Railway Company, Portland Trust Company of Oregon and M. Senders and Company are the only corporations or individuals owning property adjoining said alley or in any way interested therein, and it further appearing that it is for the public good that said alley heretofore described be vacated;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That that certain alley lying between lots two (2) and three (3) block twelve (12), and lots four (4), five (5) and six (6), block twelve (12), Albany, Oregon, and the whole thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.
