

ORDINANCE NO. 311

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PURCHASING FROM E. B. WILLIAMSON ONE HARLEY-DAVIDSON MOTORCYCLE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF ALBANY.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated out of the general funds of the City of Albany, Oregon the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars for the purpose of purchasing one Harley-Davidson motorcycle from E. B. Williamson for the police department of said city, and the Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to draw a warrant on the general funds of said city in favor of the said E. B. Williamson for the amount hereby appropriated.
