

ORDINANCE NO. 946.

AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED
"AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE SPREAD OF
VENEREAL DISEASES, AND TO PRESCRIBE A PENALTY FOR VIOL-
ATION HEREOF."

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 922 entitled "An Ordinance to re-
gulate and control the spread of venereal diseases and to prescribe a penalty
for violation hereof" passed by the Council April 24, 1918 and approved by the
Mayor April 27, 1918, be and the same is hereby repealed.


