

# ORDINANCE NO. 1013.

AN ORDINANCE, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND RECORDER OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH GAMEWELL FIRE ALARM TELEGRAPH CO. FOR THE REPAIR AND ENLARGEMENT OF THE FIRE ALARM SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 27 the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, deemed it expedient and necessary that the Fire Alarm system of the City of Albany, Oregon, shall be repaired and enlarged, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon in and by said Resolution No. 27 did authorize and direct the Recorder of said city to give due notice as required by the charter and ordinances of said city of said work and labor to be performed and materials to be used in making said repairs and improvement, and

WHEREAS, in pursuance of said Resolution No. 27 the Recorder of the City of Albany, Oregon, gave due and regular notice as required by the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon, of the work and labor to be performed and the materials to be used in the repair and enlargement of the fire alarm system of the City of Albany, Oregon.

Section 1. That the bid of \$ 1065.00 for the improvement, repair and enlargement of the fire alarm system of the City of Albany, Oregon, be and the same is hereby accepted and the Mayor and Recorder of said City are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract in writing with the Gamewell Fire Alarm Telegraph Co. for the performance of said work and labor and the furnishing of said materials upon the terms in said bid hereinabove mentioned and in accordance with the charter and ordinances of the City of Albany, Oregon

Said contract to further provide that said work, labor, repair and enlargement of the said fire alarm system shall commence within 120 days after the signing of this contract and shall be prosecuted with such vigor that all of the work embraced in said contract shall be entirely completed on or before the 1st day of March, 1922 and the City of Albany shall be deemed to suffer damages to the extent of \$ 5.00 per day for each and every day said work and labor is delayed beyond the specified time and that the said Gamewell Fire Alarm Telegraph Co. furnish and provide a good and sufficient bond in the sum of \$ 800.00 to be approved by the Mayor of the City of Albany, Oregon, having as surety some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Oregon or some individual justifying in double the amount of said bond, conditioned for the faithful performance of said contract on the part of Gamewell Fire Alarm Telegraph Co. and further indemnifying the City of Albany against any claim or lien for labor, work or materials on the part of any person, firm or corporation, arising out of said contract.


