

ORDINANCE No. 1245

AN ORDINANCE to ascertain and determine the probable cost of constructing a lateral sewer, which the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, has determined by Resolution No. 7, adopted on the 23rd day of March, 1927, beginning at the manhole in the Geary Street Trunk sewer, which is 18 feet easterly from the southeast corner of lot 5 in Block 18, in Hackleman's 4th Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence running westerly through the center of Blocks 18 and 13, in said Addition, a distance of 632 feet to the southwest corner of lot 1 in block 13 in said Hackleman's Fourth Addition, to ascertain, assess, determine and declare the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement that is assessed upon the lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land adjacent to said improvement; to direct the Recorder of said City to enter a statement of said assessment in the Docket of City Liens, as provided by the charter of said City:

WHEREAS, on March 23, 1927 the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon, duly adopted a resolution requiring Charles H. Leonard, engineer, to prepare plans and specifications for the construction of a lateral sewer, beginning at the manhole in the Geary Street Trunk sewer, which is 18 feet easterly from the southeast corner of lot 5 in Block 18, in Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence running westerly through the center of blocks 18 and 13, in said Addition, a distance of 632 feet to the southwest corner of lot 1 in block 13, in said Addition, and for estimates of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and requiring such plans, specifications and estimates of probable cost to be filed in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 13th day of March, 1927, and

WHEREAS, said Engineer pursuant to said Resolution No. 7, made plans, specifications and estimates, as directed, for the construction of said lateral sewer, and filed the same with the Recorder, as aforesaid, on the 23rd day of March, 1927, and

WHEREAS, the Council on the 23rd day of March, 1927, by Resolution 7, duly adopted by the Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it expedient, and said Council proposed to construct said lateral sewer, as hereinabove directed, and

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of said Resolution No. 7 gave due notice of said improvement in the manner provided by the charter of said City, and on the 11th day of May, 1927, pursuant to said notice, Yunker, Wiecks & Co. submitted its bid to the Council for the making of said improvement for the sum of \$782.40, which said bid was received and accepted in and by ordinance No. 1247, passed by the Council on the 11th day of May, 1927, and approved by the Mayor on the 11th day of May, 1927.

THEREFORE THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That an eight inch vitrified terra cotta sewer shall be constructed, beginning at the manhole in the Geary Street Trunk sewer, which is 18 feet easterly from the southeast corner of lot 5 in block 18 in Hackleman's Fourth Addition to the City of Albany, Oregon, thence running westerly through the center of blocks 18 and 13, a distance of 632 feet, to the southwest corner of lot 1 in block 13 in said Addition, in accordance with Resolution No. 7, and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by Charles H. Leonard in the office of the Recorder of said City on the 23rd day of March, 1927.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making such improvement in the manner hereinabove determined by the Council of said City, by Resolution No. 7, and by the bid of said Yunker, Wiecks & Co. is hereby declared to be the sum of \$898.00, and the probable cost of said improvement to be paid by the owners of the property adjacent thereto, and particularly benefited thereby is the sum of \$727.20.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement assessed upon each lot, or part thereof, or parcel or tract of land adjacent thereto, as assessed and determined by the Council, is hereby determined and ascertained to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate description of said lots, or parts thereof, or parcels or tracts of land, as follows, to-wit:
