

ORDINANCE NO. 1384

AN ORDINANCE To appropriate the sum of \$874.85 of the Street Funds of the City of Albany for the purpose of purchasing one Chevrolet Truck and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of \$874.85 of the Street Funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, for the purpose of purchasing one Chevrolet Truck for the use of the Street department of said City.

Section 2. The recorder is hereby authorized and directed to issue a warrant drawn on the Street fund of the City of Albany in the sum of \$874.85, payable to Albany Auto Company in payment of the purchase price of the Chevrolet truck mentioned in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the City of Albany require that this ordinance shall become immediately effective, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become effective immediately after its final passage of the Council and approval by the Mayor.
