

## ORDINANCE NO. 1544

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate the sum of \$1379.12 of the Street Funds of the City of Albany for the purchase of one one and a half ton G.M.C. Truck for Street Department use and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the Street Fund of the City of Albany the sum of \$1379.12 for the purpose of purchasing from the Albany Auto Company one one and one half ton G.M.C. Truck for the use of the Street Department of said City. The Recorder is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver to the Albany Auto Company a warrant drawn against the street fund of said City for the amount hereby appropriated upon acceptance of said truck by the Council.

Section 2. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall become in full force and effect upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
