of Albany. AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1495 of the City ✓

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 1495 of the City of Albany be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 1. It is hereby declared to be unlawful for any person or persons, running, conducting or managing a locomotive railroad train or electric railroad train, to run said locomotive or electric railroad train on any main line railroad track within the corporate limits of the City of Albany at greater rate of speed than thirty (30) miles per hour."
