

ORDINANCE NO. 1552

A Bill for

AN ORDINANCE appropriating the sum of \$400.00 from the General Funds of the City of Albany, Oregon in Payment of the purchase price of one 1942 Plymouth Special 4-Door DeLux Sedan for the use of the Police Department of said City and declaring an emergency.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and is hereby appropriated from the General Funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, the sum of \$400.00 for the purchase price of one 1942 Plymouth Special 4-Door DeLux Sedan for the use of the Police Dept. of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of said City is hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the General Fund Warrant of said City in the sum of \$400.00 payable to Ralston Motor Co. in payment of the purchase price of said automobile heretofore purchased; and balance of said purchase price being represented by trading in a second hand automobile on an account thereof.

Section 3. Whereas, the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany is involved, therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall become immediately effective upon its final passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
