

ORDINANCE NO. 1722

A BILL FOR:

AN ORDINANCE to appropriate \$727.76 out of the parking meter funds of the City of Albany to be used in payment for 1 Harley Davidson Motorcycle, and authorizing payment of the same to be made to East Side Motorcycle Co.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the parking meter funds of the City of Albany, Oregon, and charged to the parking meter funds, the sum of \$727.76 it being the price heretofore agreed upon with the East Side Motorcycle Co. for 1 Harley Davidson Motorcycle as shown by the invoice therefor now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to the East Side Motorcycle Co. the parking meter fund warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriated shall be charged against the parking meter fund of said City.
