

**ORDINANCE NO.** 1774

**A BILL FOR:**

**AN ORDINANCE** to appropriate \$425.00 out of the General Fund of the City of Albany to be used in payment for architectural services and preparation of report on development of School and Park Sites and authorizing payment of the same to Jacobberger, Stanton and Zeller.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the City of Albany, Oregon, and charged to the Park Improvement Fund, the sum of \$425.00, it being the price heretofore agreed upon, with Jacobberger, Stanton and Zeller, for architectural services and preparations of report on development of School and Park sites, as shown by the invoice therefore now on file in the office of the City Recorder of said City.

Section 2. The Recorder of the City of Albany is hereby directed to execute and deliver to Jacobberger, Stanton and Zeller the General Fund Warrant of the City of Albany in payment of the amount and for the purpose of the appropriation as hereinabove set against the Park Improvement Fund of said City.
