

ORDINANCE No. 1891

A BILL FOR:

An Ordinance prohibiting the parking of trucks over a certain weight rating, overnight and on Sundays and holidays.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That it shall be unlawful to park upon any street, alleyway, sidewalk or parking strip in the city of Albany, Oregon any truck tractors with trailer, any trailer house, semi-trailer or pole trailer attached to or carried upon any truck, or any truck having a load capacity of one and one-half tons or more overnight and on Sundays and holidays.

That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to violate a provision of this ordinance.

Such conviction for the violation of the ordinance shall be governed by and punished under the provisions of Ordinance No. 1422, Section 84 thereof, which ordinance pertains to the regulation of traffic upon the streets of the City of Albany.
