WHEREAS, on the 25th day of May, 1948, the Council of the City of Albany, Oregon duly adopted a resolution requiring the City In inser of said City to make plans and specifications for the improvement of <u>FLOVE IN STREAT</u> from the East line of Liberty to the West line of Cottage Street in the following manner to-wit:

By grading and graveling of said street. By laying and constructing concrete gutters. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalks. By installing a proper drainage system.

and for the estimates of the work to be done on said portion of said Street and the probable cost thereof and requiring that such plane, specifications and estimates and probable cost be filed in the Recorder's office of said City, said Resolution being endorsed, "Resolution No. 10", and adopted on the 25th day of May., 1948,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer of said City of Albany pursuant to said Resolution No. 10 made plans, specifications and estimates as directed by the said resolution for the improvement of said Street in the manner specified in said Resolution No. 10 and filed said plans, specifications and estimates in the Recorder's office of said City on the 10th day of June 1948.

WHEREAS the Council on the 9th day of June 1945 by Resolution No. 23 duly adopted by said Council, determined and resolved that it deemed it especient and that said Council proposed to improve TETYSTH STREIT from the East line of Liberty to the West line of Cottage Street in the manner provided in said Resolution No. 23, and:

WHERMAS, in and by said Resolution No. 23 adopted as aforesaid by the Council the Recorder of said City was duly ordered and directed by said Council to give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street as provided by the Charter of said City and:

WHEREAS, the Recorder in pursuance of s id order and direction of the Council of said City of Albany did duly give notice of said proposed improvement of said Street in the manner provided by the Charter of said City and:

whereas, the said Council in and by said Resolution No. 23 ascertained and determined the total probable cost of making said improvement of said Street to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of s id Street to be improved as specified in said Resolution No. 23 to se the sum of \$2,530.00.

THEREFORE

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO OR AIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That ELEVELTH STREET in the City of All any, Oregon from the East line of Liberty to the lest line of Cottage Street, be improved as

1. By grading and graveling of said street.

By laying and constructing concrete gutters. By constructing concrete curbs and sidewalts.

By installing a proper drainage system.

all in accordance with said Resolution No. 23 and the plans and specifications for said improvement filed by the City Engineer with the Recorder of said City of "lbany, Oregon on the 10th day of June 1946.

Section 2. That the probable cost of making said improvement of said Street in the manner heretofore determined by the Council of Allany in and by Resolution No. 23 to be paid by the owners of the real property adjacent to said portion of said Street is hereby declared to be the sum of \$2,630.00.

Section 3. That the proportionate share of said probable cost of said improvement of said Street assessed upon each lot or part thereof adjacent to said part of said Street to be improved as aforesaid and as determined by said Council in and by said Resolution No. 23 is hereby ascertained and declared to be the sum set and placed immediately after the separate descriptions of each of such lots or parts thereof as follows:
