ORDINANCE NO. 2146

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR AND DEFINING THE KIND AND QUALITY OF SEWER PIPE TO BE USED IN THE CONSTRUCTION OF STORM AND SANITARY SEWERS IN THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON.

THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF ALBANY DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That all storm and sanitary sewers which may hereafter be constructed in the streets and through all the alleys, in the center of all blocks, in the City of Albany, Oregon, whether such sewers are constructed by the City or by the property owners of said city, shall be constructed of vitrified pipe, concrete or cement asbestos pipe to be of the best quality and meet specifications of standard strength as per the American Society for testing materials.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage by the council and approval by the Mayor.
