

ORDINANCE NO. 2479

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A CITY HEALTH OFFICER, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT THEREOF, AND PRESCRIBING HIS DUTIES.

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Albany, in Chapter 4, Article 4, Section 76, Sub-section 20, enumerates therein the power of the common council to provide for a City Health officer, the appointment thereof, the description of their duties and the definition of their powers.

THE CITY OF ALBANY, OREGON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a person shall be selected and designated as City Health Officer to serve at the pleasure of the City Council.

Section 2. That as qualifications, said person so designated must be a member in good standing of the state and county medical societies.

Section 3. That as compensation for the duties of the said Health Officer, as hereinafter provided, he shall receive that which may be hereinafter set by resolution of the Council.

Section 4. That the duties of the said Health Officer so selected shall be to enforce the sanitary and health regulations as hereintofore and may be hereinafter established by the City of Albany and to enforce those regulations of health and sanitation as hereintofore established by the City of Albany and to enforce those regulations of health and sanitation as hereintofore and may hereinafter be established by the State Board of Health.

That the said Health Officer shall render medical assistance to the inmates of the City Jail at such times when it shall be the duty of the City of Albany to render such aid.

Section 5. Said officer shall be authorized to enlist any additional help, either from his profession or from laymen, in times of emergency and that those persons so enlisted shall be reimbursed a reasonable sum for their services by the City of Albany.

Section 6. WHEREAS, the existing conditions are such that the peace, health and safety of the people of the City of Albany are involved, therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in effect immediately upon its final passage and approval by the Mayor.
